SCHOOL UNIFORM YEARS 7 – 11

- Plain white shirt or blouse, long or short sleeve with buttons up to the neck. No badges such as rugby club badges on shirts.
- Official school tie.
- Official red school jumper with school badge. No hoodies, sports tops, cardigans or other jumpers.
- Plain black skirt no shorter than the top of the knee or plain black trousers. No jeans, culottes, cords, dungarees, leggings, capri trousers, maxi skirts or dresses.
- Black tights or black socks.
- Natural or dark hair clips and bands.
- Natural hair colour only. No unnatural hair colour, patterns or lines shaved in hair.
- Plain black shoes. No heels, boots, trainers, sandals or flip flops.
- Black, dark blue or dark grey winter coat or rain coat. No denim jackets.
- No jewellery of any kind.

Repercussions due to breaking school uniform rules

The school will keep any items of clothing that do not conform with the school rules until the last day of the half term during which the item was confiscated.

The school does not allow pupils to wear any jewellery in school. Pupils are expected to remove all jewellery before entering the school site. Items of jewellery worn in school will be handed to the relevant Head of Progress and kept safe until the end of the day in the first instance and for a period of five school days or until the Head of Progress receives a note from the parent / guardian requesting the return of the item in all instances following the first.

The Headteacher's decision is final in all matters regarding school uniform.

SCHOOL UNIFORM YEARS 12 – 13

- Plain white shirt or blouse, long or short sleeve with buttons up to the neck. No badges such as rugby club badges on shirts.
- Official Sixth Form tie (black and yellow).
- Official school black blazer with school badge.
- Plain black v-neck jumper or plain black cardigan. No hoodies, sports tops, round neck jumpers or other jumpers.
- Plain black skirt no shorter than the top of the knee or plain black trousers. No jeans, culottes, cords, dungarees, leggings, capri trousers, maxi skirts or dresses.
- Black tights or black socks.
- Natural or dark hair clips and bands.
- Natural hair colour only. No unnatural hair colour, patterns or lines shaved in hair.
- Plain black shoes. No heels, trainers, sandals or flip flops.
- Black, dark blue or dark grey winter coat or rain coat. No denim jackets.
- Pupils are permitted to wear one pair of earrings (studs) in the ears only. Nose/lip studs/earrings are not acceptable.
