

## YSGOL GYFUN GYMRAEG RHYDYWAUN SCHOOL UNIFORM SEPTEMBER 2020

At Ysgol Gyfun Rhydywaun we believe that learning to dress appropriately is part of a good education that contributes to the development of self-discipline and self-worth. Proper school uniform sets a climate of high standards, pride and order in the school.

This policy has been drawn up in order to comply with the Welsh Government's statutory guidance (document 247/2019) on school uniform.

Pupils not wearing correct uniform should be supplied with a letter from home explaining the reasons why and including a date by which the pupil will be in correct uniform. If you have any doubts as to whether an item of school uniform is correct e.g. trousers or shoes, we ask that you contact the school prior to purchasing the item.

**Pupils are expected to wear full and correct school uniform every day at school from 14 September 2020.**

### YEARS 7 - 11

- Plain white shirt or blouse with long or short sleeves with button up to the neck. No badges e.g. rugby club badge on the shirt.
- Official school tie.
- Official red school jumper with school badge.
- Official red polo shirt with school badge (*September, October, April, May, June and July only*). **Please note: the red polo shirt will not be part of Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Rhydywaun's school uniform from September 2021.**
- Plain black trousers to reach the shoe/ankle - **No Jeans, culottes, tight trousers or leggings** or plain black skirt.
- Black socks to be worn with school trousers. Black tights or black socks to be worn with school skirt.
- Plain black shoes. **No trainers.** Heels no higher than 4cm.
- Natural hair colour only.
- Black/dark blue/dark grey coloured clips and bands in hair.
- Black or dark blue/grey winter coat or raincoat - a bright stripe is permissible for visibility during the winter.
- **No hoodies or sports tops.**
- Plain black scarf, plain black or dark blue/grey winter hats.
- **No jewellery is allowed.**

## **YEARS 12 + 13**

- Plain white shirt or blouse with long or short sleeves with button up to the neck. No badges e.g. rugby club badge on the shirt.
- Official Sixth Form tie (black and yellow).
- Official school black blazer with school badge.
- Plain black trousers to reach the shoe/ankle - **No Jeans, culottes, tight trousers or leggings** or plain black skirt.
- Black socks to be worn with school trousers. Black tights or black socks to be worn with school skirt.
- Plain black shoes. **No trainers**. Heels no higher than 4cm.
- Natural hair colour only.
- Black/dark blue/dark grey coloured clips and bands in hair.
- Black or dark blue/grey winter coat or raincoat - a bright stripe is permissible for visibility during the winter.
- **No hoodies or sports tops.**
- Plain black scarf, plain black or dark blue/grey winter hats.
- Pupils are permitted to wear one pair of earrings (studs) in the ears only. Nose/lip studs/earrings are not acceptable.

## **PHYSICAL EDUCATION KIT**

### **Girls:**

- PE Department polo shirt (black and white)
- PE Department shorts or leggings
- Correct trainers (no Vans, Converse, 'High Tops' or daps)
- Optional: PE Department Hoodie or black fleece

### **Boys:**

- PE Department rugby shirt or polo shirt (black and white)
- PE Department black and white shorts
- Correct trainers (no Vans, Converse, 'High Tops' or daps)
- Rugby / Football boots (no metal studs)
- Optional: PE Department Hoodie or black fleece
